BMT: Segment 14b-14c (TN 68 to Unicoi Gap) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared April 5, 2024.

BMT: Segment 13e (Wildcat Creek to FS 22b) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared March 30, 2024.

BMT: Segment 15a (Unicoi Gap to Tate Gap) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared March 4, 2024.

BMT: Segment 7a (Weaver/Laurel Creek Rd. to GA 515) Benton MacKaye trail maintainer reported clear trail March 23, 2024.

BMT: Segment 5a-5b (Wilscot Gap to Brawley Mountain) Hiker with maintenance experience reported clear trail March 24, 2024.

BMT: Segment 6b-6c (Weaver Creek to Fall Branch Falls) Hiker with maintenance experience reported clear trail March 23, 2024.

BMT: Segment 6b-6d (Stanley Creek Road to Weaver Creek Road) Benton MacKaye trail from Fall Branch Falls is clear 3.3 miles of 6b & 6c on its shared footpath with Stanley Gap Trail March 18, 2024.

BMT: Segment 3a, 3b, 3c, 4a, 4b (GA 60 Skeenah Creek to Wilscot Gap/GA Hwy 60) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared BMT during a club work trip March 16, 2024.

BMT: Segment 13d-13e (Towee Creek to Coker Creek) Four Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared from FS 22B to Loss Creek where high water precluded further work during TN club work trip March 16, 2024.

BMT: Segment 14a (TN 68 to Coker Creek Bridge/FS 22b) Three Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared trail northbound during TN club work trip March 16, 2024.

BMT: Segment 8a-8d (Bushy Head Gap to Fowler Mountain) Two Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared Section 8a from Bushy Head Gap to Hudson Gap February 29, 2024.

BMT: Segment 15a (Unicoi Gap to Tate Gap) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared from Unicoi Gap to Tate Gap February 26 and March 4, 2024.

BMT: Segment 6b-6d (Stanley Creek Road to Weaver Creek Road) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers very quickly restored previously damaged trail from large rootball near Fall Branch Falls February 20, 2024.

BMT: Segment 12c-12d (Kimsey Mountain Hwy to Lost Creek Campground) Benton MacKaye trail maintainers cleared Segments 12 b, c and e Dry Pond lead to FS 173 trestle February 10, 2024.
